The VIPDC will conduct an approved Walking Field Trial on April 7th and 8th, 2018 at Springford Farm, 1884 Northwest Bay Road, NanOOSE, BC NanOOSE Bay, BC. The Trial is held under the pointing breeds Field Trial and Field Dog Test Rules and Regulations, effective January 1, 2018, of the Canadian Kennel Club, Suite 400-200 Robson Drive, Etobicoke, Ontario, M9W 5Z9 and the minimum requirements of the Amateur Field Trial Clubs of America, 360 Winchester Lane, Stanton TN USA 36069.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- All stakes are walking stakes. Horses are neither required by handlers nor allowed. Blank pistols, .22 cal minimum will be fired over all dogs with bird work in the senior and derby stakes. Blank pistols may be fired over puppies if both handlers agree. No live ammunition will be allowed in any stake. Pistols must have solid barrels
- Courses and Birds: All **courses will be a Single course without Bird Field.** Chukar, Pheasant, Quail or alternate game birds will be released throughout the course for all stakes except puppy. There will be no birds released for Puppy Stakes. In the advent of adverse course conditions the Field Trial Chairman may adjust the course.
- Total entries will be limited to the number of dogs that can be run in the available daylight hours
- The senior stakes will be 30 minutes in length; the derby and puppy stakes will be 20 minutes. The Club reserves the right to rearrange the running order of the stakes should conditions warrant
- Collaring a dog away after game contact will be allowed.
- **Bitches in season will be not permitted to run.**
- Tracking Collars: Approved electronic collars may be used. Any questions regarding their use should be referred to the Field Trial Chairman.
- All participants must be familiar with the CKC Rules and also the rules and provisions of this Premium List. CKC Field Trial rulebooks are available from the CKC or on-line at the CKC website for CKC members.
- **It shall be the duty and obligation of the Trial-giving Club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or competitor at a Field Trial is not subject to indignities. The Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on the receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.**

PRIZES: Standard CKC rosettes and plaques will be awarded to the placing dogs in all stakes as appropriate.

Cash prizes will be awarded as follows:

1st Place Open Shooting \$500.00

2nd Place Open Shooting \$250.00

1st Place Dog in Derby. 250.00

AFTCA will award win certificates to all qualified dogs placing first, second or third in all AFTCA stakes.

The draw will be held at the above address after closing. ENTRY FEES that accompany a paper entry are to be paid in Canadian funds by cash, cheque or money order payable to the Vancouver Island Pointing Dog Club. All entry forms are to be completed and in the hands of the Field Trial Secretary and entry fees paid in full prior to the running of the dog

LISTING FEE: A listing fee of \$10.50, as established by the Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN), Performance Event Number (PEN) or Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) is not shown on the entry form. This listing fee is per dog per each event entered during the Field Trial and is in addition to the entry fee(s).

All entries are accepted on the condition that the Vancouver Island Pointing Dog Club, its officers, directors, membership and landowners assume no responsibility for participants or spectators in the event of injury or damage to persons, animals, or properties in conjunction with or during the running of the Field Trial. All minors shall be under the direct care and supervision of the parent or guardian.

BORDER CROSSING: A rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into or out of Canada and the rabies certificate must be dated at least 30 days prior to crossing the border.

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2011 Non-member participation fee

a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

c) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

Field Trial Location: Springford Farm, 1884 Northwest Bay Road, Nanoose Bay, BC. Northwest Bay Road is located approximately 24 km North of Nanaimo on the Island Highway (#19). Nanaimo on Vancouver Island by BC Ferries from either Horseshoe Bay Terminal to Departure Bay just north of Nanaimo or Tsawwassen to Duke Point just south of Nanaimo. Please check BC Ferries website at www.bcferrries.com for official times and fares. Once you are off the ferry you will take Highway 19 North past Nanaimo until you reach Nanoose Bay, turn right at the light at the Petrocan Station (you are now on Northwest Bay Road). Continue approximately 5 kms until you see the pointing dog signs. Please follow the pointing dog signs to the west edge of the property and refrain from using the main drive to house or barns.

The club is grateful to the Springford family for allowing access to these grounds.

We ask for your cooperation in keeping grounds free of litter.

There will be no exercising or training of any dogs on the Trial grounds before, during or after the trial without the explicit permission from the Field Trial Chairman.
